Dear Mr. Power

Further to your recent enquiry I am able to confirm that there were Church of England Chapels on the River Mersey, but am afraid that we do not hold their records.

I have found the burial record for Thomas Power in Toxteth Park Cemetery. He was buried on 21 October 1890, Section A Right No 911 and is described as Master Mariner aged 71 years. His address is given as Turner Memorial Home. I have also found Elizabeth Power and attach a copy of her burial record. The grave is evidently a family grave and I would have assumed she was Thomas's wife if were not for the fact that she is described as a widow and died two years earlier. She appears in the March quarter of the St. Cath's index ref. 8b 207. Harry Bailey Power does not appear in the Lancs section of the 1881 Census Index.
